A Resource Directory for American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) Elders



As a Community Service Provider, you may be well aware of disparities in access to services and resources among AI/AN Elders. However, you may not be aware that there is a free online directory being developed with localized listings of **health and social services and resources for AI/AN Elders** across Indian Country.

The National Indian Council on Aging (NICOA), a non-profit organization working to advocate for AI/AN Elders, is cooperating with all federally-recognized tribes, pueblos, bands, and nations to create this friendly and easy to use website. It allows Elders, their families and caregivers, as well as community service providers to quickly find the following:

- Caregiver Services
- Economic Wellbeing Resources
- Food & Nutrition Services
- Health Service Providers
- Housing

- In-Home Services
- Long-Term Care & Support Services
- Elder Centers -Title VI
- Transportation

This directory is **free** and **does not require registration of any kind.** It can be conveniently accessed from computers, smartphones or tablets at any time.

Search by category, keyword or advanced search options. For example: Transportation.






With search results listing displayed select from the tribe names (big blue text) to view area services. For example:
